


Critical Challenges for Consideration

Requirements for decisions to be made by consensus (whether by design or as a result of bracketed voting procedures) prevents adoption. Even if adopted treaty amendments and protocols are likely to require many more years to reach the ratification threshold for entry into force. Proposals risk being abandoned because of lack of majority support/ failed vote.
