# WOMEN ENVIRONMENTAL HUMAN RIGHTS DEFENDERS' PROTECTION IN THE LIMA WORK PROGRAMME

#### WHAT

- The Lima Work Program on Gender provides a critical opportunity to monitor and address all forms of violence and discrimination targeting women environmental human rights defenders, including those standing up for climate justice.
- A strong outcome can contribute to dismantling the structural, social, economic, and regulatory barriers that hinder environmental defenders' participation in UNFCCC processes.

## WHY

 Women environmental human rights defenders are at the frontline of climate action. It is imperative to eliminate, prevent, and respond to all forms of discrimination and violence, including gender-based violence, against women defending the environment, whose vulnerability is exacerbated by gender-based threats, the disproportionate impact of the climate change crisis and the cultural, economic and social obstacles they face due to existing gender inequalities.



### OUR DEMANDS

- Clear mechanisms must be established to eliminate, prevent, and respond to genderbased discrimination and violence, ensuring comprehensive protection and support for those standing up for environmental rights, including women environmental human rights defenders.
- The Program and its respective Gender Action Plan must actively ensure safe and inclusive participation while fostering an enabling environment free from criminalization and threats for climate defenders.
